Top 5 tips on how to support students after the January deadline

1. If your students have used all five choices on their applications but are not holding any offers, they may be eligible to use EXTRA when it opens on 28 February. <u>Find out more.</u>

2. Students can make some changes to their application after submission, or they might need to contact the university or college. What they need to know.

3. Once the application has been submitted, students can sign in

anytime to track their application and find out about the <u>different offers</u> they may receive and the dates to reply.

4. <u>It's not too late to apply.</u> Applications can be submitted until 30 June 2023 when they will be entered into <u>Clearing.</u>

5. Students can access the latest advice on finance and accommodation on <u>ucas.com</u>

There are lots of reason why your students may not have met the deadline, and although it sounds scary, this is not the end of the world.
